I am a 20 year old Junior attending Southern Nazarene University, and I have many roles here on campus. I work in the admissions office to both earn scholarship money and make money while I am in school. I played basketball last year with the JV program, and we had a successful season, but I chose not to play my sophomore year because I am going to graduate a year early and needed to get practicum/internship experience on my resume for graduate programs to consider me. I love to coach and ref sports, and I had a job with the Bethany First Church kids' league as a referee for the course of the season both this year and last. Next semester, I am actually taking a joint coaching and reffing class to hone my skills and maybe even get certified to ref at the higher levels in the future. Next year is my senior year, and I am going to another practicum experience through the Oklahoma City Indian Clinic to hopefully gain more experience to possibly come back and work in mental health for a tribe close to home. I plan to go to graduate school at SNU or somewhere else close by once I graduate.

This scholarship will be extremely helpful in allowing me to pay off my undergraduate studies before I enter into graduate school in August 2026. I have two loving parents that support me with my needs and always put clothes on my back and food on the table and I am extremely grateful for that. Going to college in Oklahoma has been good for me because it is cheaper than in-state tuition in Colorado. I am applying for this scholarship to try and pay off my undergraduate studies before I inevitably go to graduate school as that is what my career field will require in order to get a decent job. I know that this scholarship is a stepping stone to help pay for my undergraduate before I go into the more expensive graduate school. I've been offered an unsubsidized loan from the government for \$5,500. These loans start accruing interest right away. I am applying for local scholarships so I hopefully will not need to take out loans for my undergraduate education. SNU Total Cost: \$40,470 Scholarships Received: \$25,000.

Thank you very much for your continued support over the last 2 years and thank you for your consideration this year.



I am privileged to take this opportunity to strongly recommend Gabe Crowley for this scholarship.


