Occasionally, Empire Electric schedules maintenance that involves a planned outage. One of Empire's substations serving the Pleasant View area has been taken off line and those meters need to be reset to send data to the Anasazi Substation. In order to accomplish this, a short outage is required. This Friday, May 27, 2016, there will be a ten second outage around midnight for members living in the Pleasant View area. This outage will affect approximately 450 meters.

This maintenance is required to provide the safe, reliable service that our members warrant. We apologize in advance for any inconvenience this may cause. It is suggested that any critical systems you may have running be powered down and any safeguards for backing up computers be implemented before the scheduled outage time.
